	Treatment Plan: To continue 1-1 counselling for ongoing support to maintain abstinence from alcohol and for to attend House.
	Intervention: Validated for nil alcohol use and reflected his concerns about the court case and how his past always impacted on his life. Allowed to explore how his past always impacted on him and how he was always seeking a sense of safety and anxious about how long he would have in his current situation. became aware that he had become somewhat stuck by his circumstances and remembered how as a teenager he initially wanted to be able to live a carefree lifestyle amongst nature. Allowed to explore how he had become stuck living in a city, in a flat without a job and restricted by living on a benefit. became aware how he found it difficult to trust other people and be carefree.
