This is a summary of notes from 2 volumes of notes

Summary of treatment:

presented to central in January 2006 with a binge pattern of alcohol use and suffering depression. He had previously completed the Hamner Springs programme several years earlier completed the programme and attended some individual counselling.

returned to in February 2008 reporting that he could binge on alcohol for up to 5 days at a time. He was allocated to C H and completed 20 sessions of individual counselling before being transferred to myself for ongoing support. During this time he got intoxicated on one occasion. This resulted in a charge of assault and resisting arrest.

has completed a further 10 sessions with me and has achieved nil use of alcohol for the past 2.5 months although still experiences cravings.

Physical Health - nil current issues identified.

Mental Health - shows symptoms of obsessional thought patterns and feels angry towards people in authority.

Social is currently living in a flat with a flatmate in He lives a relatively isolated lifestyle with all his family members living in appears to be very angry with members of his family and resentful about the fact they have never visited him in New Zealand and consider his moving to New Zealand as turning away from his family.

Risk statement and risk history:

No current or previous risk issues identified.

Stakeholders - has been referred to House to attend the group to learn emotional regulation skills. At this time House is unable to offer him a place in the group until February 2010.
